



Gentlemen:

Please be advised that the National Review Committee, on January 10, 2006, adopted a motion that the claim of the Union be upheld for pension contributions on behalf of the grievant for each month the grievant was not allowed to return to his regular job, excluding those months the grievant had such contributions paid on his behalf by virtue of other employment, not to exceed a maximum of six (6) months. In the future, the 3<sup>rd</sup> doctor provisions of all of the respective Supplemental Agreements will not have application in cases involving DOT medical examinations.
